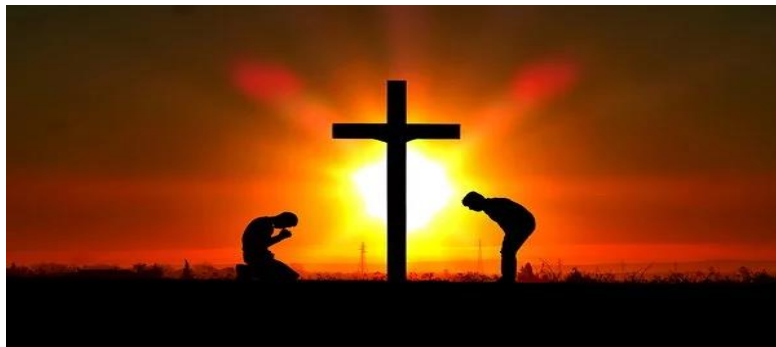
## Winter Electives
